K-12 Code of Conduct Review

Per Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 392.4644, a principal, in consultation with site administration, licensed personnel, support professionals, and parents and/or guardians of students from the school, shall annually review the *Clark County School District K-12 Student Code of Conduct*.

The discipline plan review requirement may be accomplished during November or December School Organizational Team (SOT) meetings. The review should be an official agenda item, and SOT members can review the established *Clark County School District K-12 Student Code of Conduct* for content and possible revisions.
